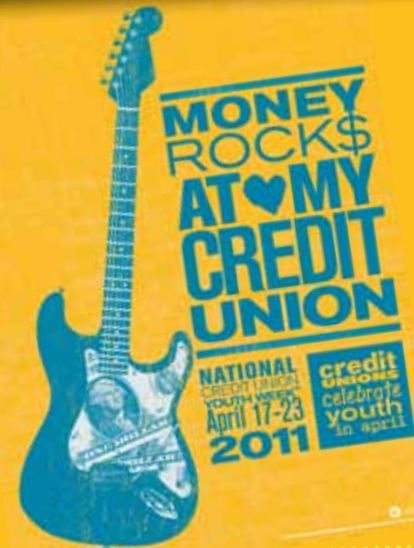
Money Rock\$ During Youth Week

MIDDLE SCHOOL:

EASTER BUNNY CUPCAKES RECIPE

INGREDIENTS:

- Cupcakes (baked from your favorite recipe)
- White icing
- Shredded coconut
- Pink decorators' sugar
- Jelly bean nose
- Chewable Sweet Tart eyes
- Large marshmallow
- Mini marshmallows

INSTRUCTIONS:

Frost a cupcakes with white icing and sprinkle on shredded coconut fur. Cut a large marshmallow in half widthwise. Squeeze each half slightly to give it an oval shape, then decorate the sticky side of each one with pink decorators' sugar and set them in place for ears. Add a jelly bean nose and either jelly bean or snipped Sweet Tart eyes, and mini marshmallows for cheeks. For a finishing touch, draw on decorators' gel pupils or whiskers. (From Family Fun)

- Tape the holder to the straw. Pour bubbles into bowl. Dip into bubbles and twirl around.

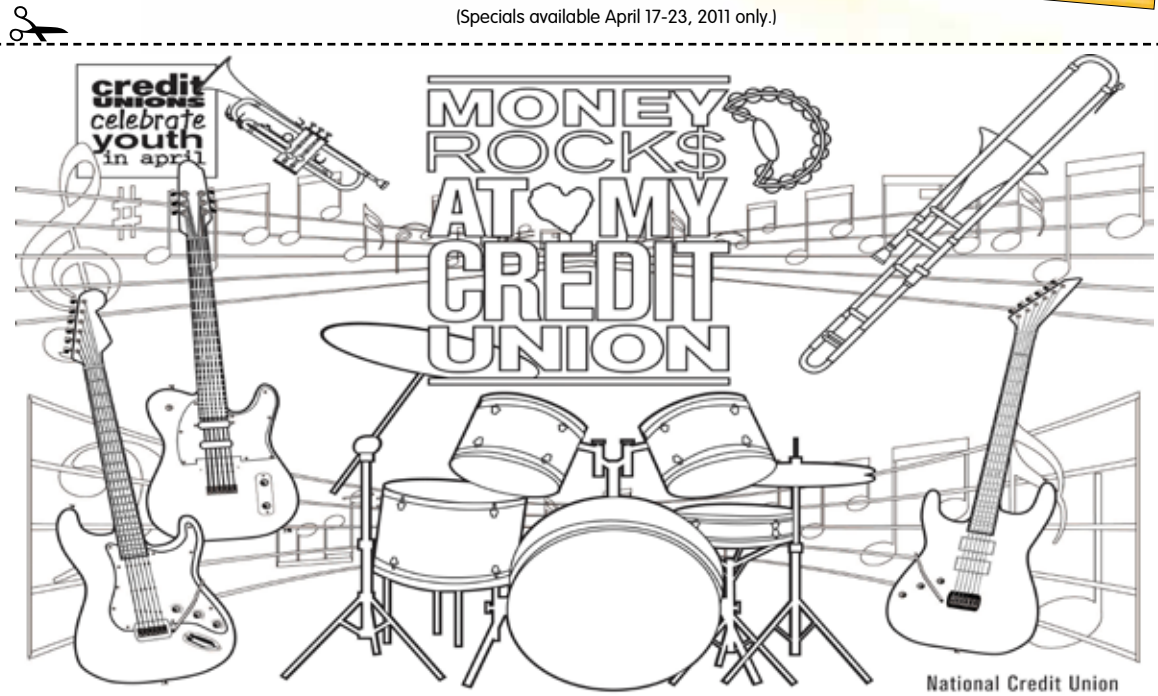
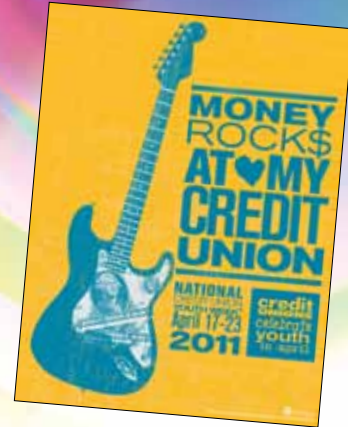
